Beach walks have been among my favorites through the years. We've been fortunate to regularly vacation along the Florida panhandle where the sand is white and fine in texture. Sunrise strolls are an almost every morning thing for me. I head out to the east or west on the firmer sand since it makes the walk that much easier. This allows plenty of space for my thoughts and feelings, for observing and listening to what's around me and to God.




Register Here For Family Camp Sept. 25 - 27
